The Government of Rwanda, through the Ministry of Education (MINEDUC) and the Rwanda Basic Education Board (REB) is implementing the "Rwanda Quality Basic Education for Human Capital Development" (RQBEHCD) Project. Within this project, The University of Rwanda in partnership with REB are implementing a CPD in Innovative Teaching Maths and Science (CPD-ITMS) programme and CPD Diploma in Inclusive Quality Education for Primary and secondary school teachers.
